International webinar- Department of Social Sciences 2020

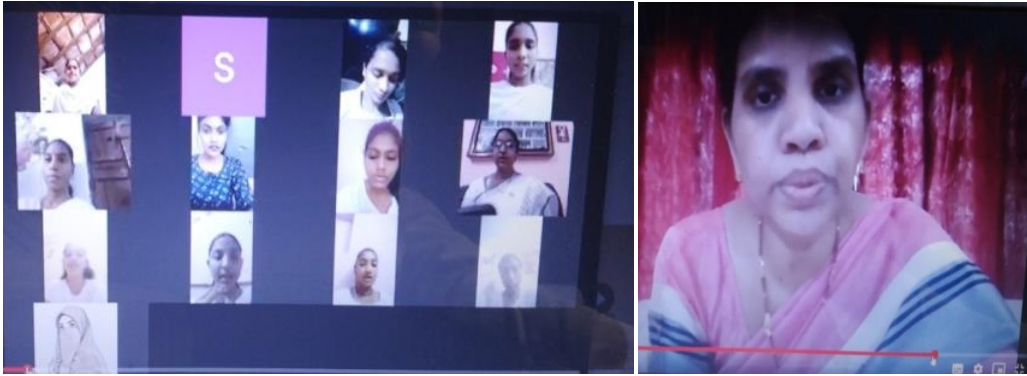

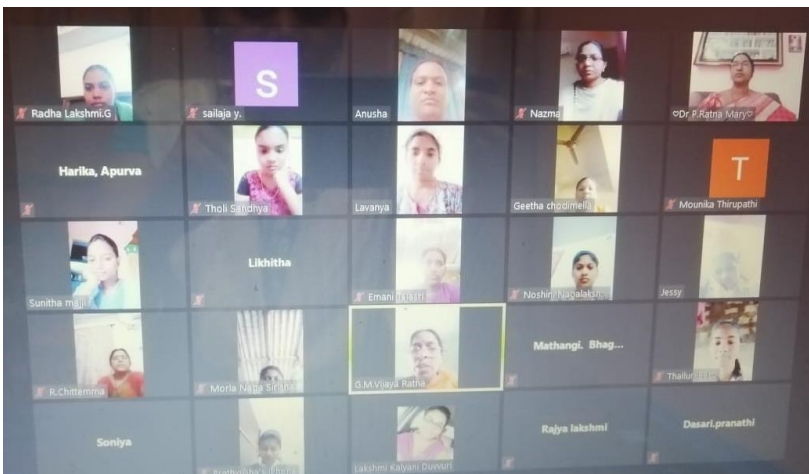
Independence day Celebrations 2020

Special achievements

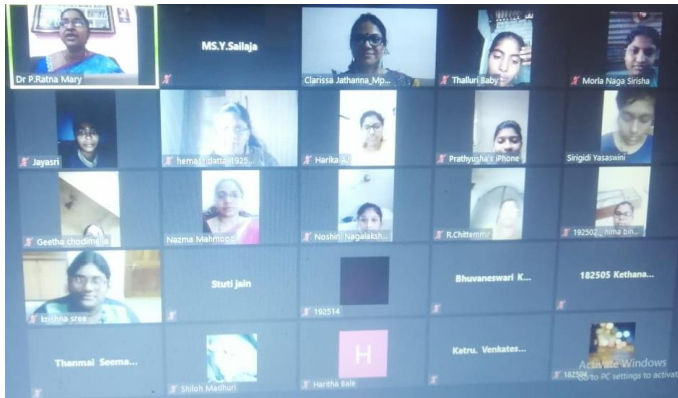

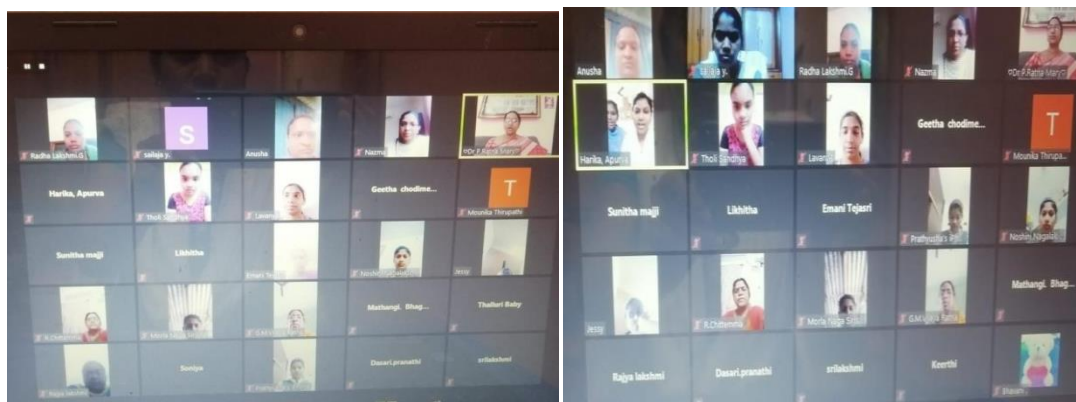
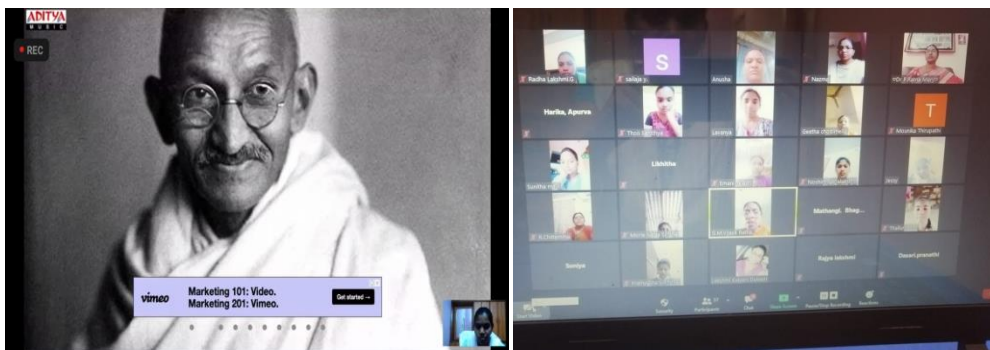
Leadership Training camp 2020
