
# DEPARTMENT OF BOTANY 2020-21 Activities

#### 1. Workshop on Nursery Raising & Plantation 2020-2021

Botany department organised a workshop on "Nursery Raising & Plantation" at Ch.S.D.St Theresa's College for Women (A), Eluru on  $1^{st} \& 2^{nd}$  December 2020. As a part of their practical III BZC students have sow the seeds of various vegetables like Tomato, Brinjal, Chilli & Beans in the campus green house. The main Aim behind organizing this workshop is to promote "Organic Kitchen Garden" at our house to lead a healthier life – under the concept of "Seed to Land, Land to Plant, Plant to Home, Home to Kitchen".

Principal Rev.Dr.Sr.Marietta D'Mello addressed the students in the workshop and congratulated the faculty of Botany & BZC students for organizing such an innovative workshop. She said all these activities are life giving well-liked the workshop.

HOD of Zoology Dr.R. Indira congratulated the staff & students. She has enlightened the students to inculcate the habit of establishing Kitchen Garden.



Botany department along with the students have distributed the saplings of vegetables i.e., tomato, Brinjal Beans & Chilli in the campus. They have sold the bundle (2 Brinjal, 2 Tomato, 2 Beans, 2 Chilli) at a reasonable price of just rupees 10. Later the saplings were distributed to various departments.

Dr.BBRG. Vijaya Lakshmi, HOD of Botany has greeted the principal and thanked her for accepting the invitation. Mrs.G Rani, faculty of Botany has spoke on the techniques of growing vegetable plants. Ms. B.Asha Latha, faculty of Botany, Md. Shaheen Botany Club President, Sk.Haveela Begum Secretory actively participated in the workshop. BZC students expressed a hearty gratitude to the Botany department as this workshop was a part of creative learning which improve their practical skills. 40 students were benefitted from this workshop.



#### 2. Theresian Organic Kitchen Garden

To promote safe vegetable production and secure food supply, Department of Botany Ch.S.D.St.Theresas's College For Women (A), Eluru, is establishing Theresian organic kitchen garden in half an acre area near community college. Area is divided into two blocks, one is meant for popular vegetables like Lady's finger, Brinjal, Tomato, two varieties of Chilli, two varieties of Beans and the other block meant for creeping vegetables like Cucumber, Bottle gourd and Bitter gourd. 150 saplings of Lady's finger, 100 saplings of Brinjal, 150 saplings of Chillies, 50 saplings of Tomato, 150 saplings of beans, 50 saplings of soybeans, 10 saplings of ridge gourd are planted. By using Vermicompost, Ghanajeevamruthamu, Neem decoctions are used to promote Organic vegetables. Each block is divided into plots and each plot planted with one variety of vegetable. Marigold plants are planted as border for each plot as it is a natural biopesticide. 400 saplings of Marigold plants are planted. Principal Dr.Sr.Marietta D'Mello blessed the activity and planted the saplings on 17<sup>th</sup> December. Vice Principal Dr.Sr.Showrilu also planted some saplings. This activity comes under Skill Development Programe under EDC. Principal Dr. Sr. Marietta D'Mello Congratulated Botany faculty Dr.B.B.R.G Vijaya Lakshmi HOD of Botany, Mrs. G.Rani and Ms.B.Asha Latha.

# January 2021:

1. **6<sup>th</sup> January 2021: Azolla Inoculation in Paddy fields** – Dept of Botany cultivated Azolla in Green house and harvested for inoculation. Dept of Botany along with I BZC students inoculated Azolla in paddy field of St.Ann's convent, to promote the organic farming, to minimize the use of synthetic fertilizers in the agricultural lands and to reduce the soil pollution,. Principal Dr.Sr.Marietta D'Mello inspired the students by her encouraging words, explained the importance of practicals in Botany and also congratulated the wonderful and skill development activity done by Dept of Botany.



# 2. Azolla cultivation and Inoculation: 2020-21

To promote organic farming in paddy fields, Dept of Botany inoculated Azolla in one acre paddy field of St.Ann's Convent on 6<sup>th</sup> January 2021. Azolla is a bio-fertilizer ,it fixes the atmospheric nitrogen in their leaves due to the association of Azolla - Anabaena bacteria. Itspreads rapidly and doubles it's bio-mass within one week. I BZC students participated as a part of their practical work under economic importance of blue green algae. Students joyfully involved in the inoculation of Azolla in the paddy field. Principal Dr.Sr.MariettaD'Mello inspired the students by her encouraging words and explained the importance of Botany practicals. Principal congratulated the wonderful skill development activity done by the Dept. of Botany. Students participated actively inthis eco-friendly practice and enjoyed a lot. Dr.B.B.R.G.Vijaya Lakshmi, HOD of Botany, Mrs.G.Rani, Ms.B.Asha Latha, Lecturers in Botany co-ordinatedthe activity.)



3. 7<sup>th</sup> January 2021: Organic kitchen garden – I BZC students cleaned the vegetable plots like Chilli and Brinjal of the organic kitchen garden by removing the weeds and also applied vermi-compost to all the vegetable plots like Chilli, Brinjal, Lady's finger, Tomato and Broad beans. Botany faculty guided the students on usage of vermin-compost explained the importance of organic cultivation techniques.

Mr. Murali Krishna, Secretory of Gosamrakshana Samithi, Eluru acted as resource person. He trained the students about the preparation of Ghana and Dravajeevamruthamu. III B.Z.C students were prepared 200 litres of Dravajeevamrutham. He suggested biopesticidal practices of Neem decoction and PL preparations to eliminate pests in Organic Kitchen Garden. 30 students were benefitted from this programme.



6. 22<sup>nd</sup> January 2021: Azolla as Animal Feed - III B.Z.C cluster students harvested Azolla and supplied as food supplement to cattle and cows of St.Ann's Convent to increase the

milk production. They received the feedback from farmer that milk production has been increased.



## February 2021:

 6<sup>th</sup> February 2021: First harvesting of Vegetables and Marigold flowers – Botany cluster students harvested 2 to 5kgs of beans, chillies, Cluster beans and Marigold flowers and offered to St. Ann's convent. Superior Dr.Sr.Marietta pudota, Principal Dr.Sr.Marietta D'Mello, Vice Principal Dr.Sr.Showrilu congratulated botany faculty and students.



 7<sup>th</sup> February 2021: Spraying of Bio-Fertilizers – Botany cluster students prepared Dravajeevamrutham and sprayed in all plots of Theresian Organic Kitchen garden to promote sustainable Oleri-culture techniques.



9<sup>th</sup> February 2021: Preparation of Bio-Pesticides - Botany cluster students' prepare Bio-pesticide decoctions of Vavilaaku, Neem and Datura in the Botany lab.



4. **11<sup>th</sup> February 2021: Spraying of Bio-Pesticides -** Botany cluster students' prepare Bio-pesticide decoctions of Vavilaaku, Neem and Datura. They applied these decoctions to beans, chilli plots in the Theresian Organic kitchen garden to control pests as it is a natural control technique.



 18<sup>th</sup> February 2021: Second harvesting of Vegetables and Marigold flowers – Botany cluster students harvested 1kg of beans, 1 kg of chillies, 1 kg of Cluster beans and 300 Marigold flowers and offered to St Ann's convent sisters and staff.
