Field trip to Hyderabad:

The students of Mathematics ,Physics, Electronics and Computer combinations were taken to Hyderabad on 29th and 30th November 2016 accompanied by four faculty members.

The students visited **Nuclear fuel complex** on 29^{th} Nov in which they have witnessed the extraction of U_{235} and also the manufacturing of U_{235} pellets and also bundling unit of U_{235} .

On 30^{th} November students were taken to **NRSC / ISRO**, Balanagar where the students were given a video lecture on different Satellite Sensors which are placed at Shad Nagar and the retrieval of data using Antennas. They were also taken to Aerial facility where 3 - D pictures of different locations are developed — The Scientists also explained the use of Satellite data and pictures in Disaster management .
