**Academic Council Meeting 2019-2020**

❖ **Prayer and Welcome:**

The Academic Council meeting was conducted on **19<sup>th</sup> June, 2020**, in the Principal's office. The meeting was held **online through Zoom App**. It commenced at 9.30 a.m. with a prayer led by Sr.P.Sunila Rani. The meeting was conducted by Dr.Sr.K.Showrilu, Vice-Principal & P.G. Directress.

Dr.Sr.Marietta D' Mello accorded a warm welcome to our newly appointed correspondent Dr.Sr.Marietta Pudota. Then the Correspondent extended a cordial welcome to all the members of the Academic Council.

❖ **Presentation of College activities:**

Dr.Sr.Marietta D' Mello, Principal presented a brief report of the college activities of the academic year 2019-2020.

❖ **Ratification of Results:**

Sr.P.Sunila Rani, the Controller of Examinations presented the results of 2018-2019 which was ratified by the Academic Council.

❖ **Ratification of Boards of Studies (UG) Resolutions:**

The chair persons of various boards of studies presented the resolutions of their particular boards. Each Chair person of the UG courses presented the resolutions after which the Academic Council members sought for clarifications if any or made suggestions, followed by the resolutions were ratified.

- Dr.V.Persis, the University nominee, Fr.G.M.Victor Emmanuel, S.J. Management nominee suggested not to change the first year syllabus of all the streams as the APSCHE has given the guidelines to follow the syllabus framed by it due to the pandemic.
- Dr.D.Kalyani, University Nominee suggested if possible including the topics related to corona virus pandemic such as diagnostic practices and precaution measures to be taken to combat the COVID-19 in all the streams of life sciences.
- She also suggested incorporating the topics related to online courses, adding on courses and how to conduct the webinars in the syllabi of the web technology and multimedia course.
- Prof.Dr.Ratnakar D.B. CEO & Director (Academics) IMRF Institution of Higher Education & Research suggested providing e-library facility to the students of containment zones to fill the gap of losing the classes.
- There was a suggestion to have online training classes and programmes for the students as well as for staff. Since we are in at uncertain period of reopening the colleges for the coming academic year.

❖ **Approval of Curriculum and Syllabi of P.G. Programmes:**

With due permission of the chair person of Academic Council, the secretary presented the curriculum of the existing 8 P.G. Programmes and M.Sc. Statistics which will be started from this academic year 2020-2021 were discussed in their respective Boards of Studies and were presented for the ratification of the same. The Academic Council ratified the syllabi.

❖ **Resolutions regarding New Courses:**

The proposal to start new courses, in U.G. and P.G. was placed before the Academic Council. It was proposed to start two new U.G. courses: B.B.A. Logistics; B.Sc. Mass Communications program and P.G. M.Sc. Statistics from the Academic Year 2020-21. The syllabi and the resolutions of the new courses was presented for the ratification.

## ❖ Any other

- Dr. V. Persis, University nominee suggested encouraging the students to enroll themselves for MOOCS courses in Coursera or other courses offered by different platforms.
- The University nominee Prof.D.Kalayani suggested preparing online lectures to reach the students who can not attend the regular classes due to the pandemic and also to provide PDF text books, e-text books and e-learning opportunities.
- Fr.Victor Emmanuel S.J, Principal of Andhra Loyola College appreciated the Principal Dr.Sr.Marietta D' Mello for conducting the Academic Council meeting in systematic was even in this troubled times. He also congratulated for taking the students to over sea's learning and initiating institution and student exchange programs for a wider learning.
- He appreciated the individual and collective efforts of the management and staff and the fruit is seen in the growth and glory of the institution.
- Dr.Ratnakar the management nominee appreciated the college for the Academic measures taken to bring an associative learning center with the University of Malaysia, research collaboration and exchange programs with the Rajpak University Bangkok and accepting to be the collaborating institution in particular psychology department for research and online exchange of knowledge with the Buddhism University - Thailand.
