Item No. II - Welcome

Item No. III - A brief Review of the activities of the academic year 2017-18

Dr.Sr.Mercy P, the Principal presented a brief outline of the academic activities of the year 2017-18 (Enclosed).

Item No. IV - Change of Correspondent - Approval of new Correspondent

The Principal informed the members that Sr.Ernestine Fernandes, the Correspondent, Ch.S.D.St.Theresa's Autonomous College for Women, Eluru was appointed by the Apex body of the Congregation as the Provincial Superior of the newly erected East Indian Province of the Immaculate conception. Item No. IX - Development of the College under RUSA

Dr.Sr.Mercy P informed that the MHRD under Rashtriya Uchahatar Siksha Abhiyan (RUSA) has identified our College as "College of Excellence" on the basis of NAAC grade – A+ and other requirements. Hence our College is selected under component 8 – " enhancing Quality and Excellence in select autonomous Colleges" of RUSA 2.0 and was sanctioned Rs. 5.00 Crores for enhancing quality of Excellence. The Principal explained briefly about the project proposal that was submitted to MHRD and requested for ratification of the Detailed Project Report (DPR) and the proposals for future developments of the College utilizing the financial assistance of RUSA.

The proposal includes:

- Starting new P.G. and U.G. Courses
- Twinning Programme with National and International Universities
- · Credit transfer programme with National and International Institutions.
- Enhancing Research and Development through Staff and Student exchange programme
- Major Research Projects, Minor Research Projects, Student Projects
- IT Infrastructure development
- Development of T L facilities
- Total Quality enhancement of the College
- Mentoring selected RUSA Colleges in East and West Godavari Districts.

The members discussed the project proposal and ratified it.

Item No. X - Approval to start New Courses

The Principal presented the future prospect of starting new courses. As the College has been recognized as College of Excellence under RUSA 2.0, it is required that we start new courses and develop the College. The Principal proposed to start a second section of M.Sc. Clinical Nutrition from 2019-20 due to the great demand for the course. Other courses proposed to start in the years are:

- 6. B.Sc. Agricultural Science

Item No. XI - Institution of New Awards

It was proposed that Theresian Award of Excellence be given to Staff under the title 'Young Scientist Award' and to the student 'Best Student Project Award' with a cash award of Rs.20,000 and Rs.10,000 respectively.

The Principal informed the members that the new award was instituted by Mrs.S.Anjali, the former Typist of our College for the student who gets the highest percentage in UG Courses from the academic year 2018-19.

Item No. XII - Any other

- It was proposed by Dr.Sr.Mercy, the Principal to start an academy for Civils Coaching for the students.
- Sr.Ernestine Fernandes, the President proposed to start a Staff Welfare Fund keeping in view the increasing number of unaided Staff.
- Dr.Fr.Kishore suggested that an increase in the salary and Staff Welfare Programmes like Seed money for research, special increment for NET, SLET, Ph.D. etc.
- Sr.Ernestine Fernandes informed about the permission received from Rome to construct the 2nd floor of the new hostel building to provide better facilities for NRI students.
