The Department of English conducted a **Spell Bee Competition** final round for First year students on 5th February, 2018. A total no of 76 students participated in it. The winners are as follows :

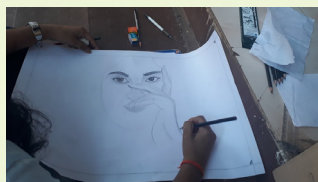

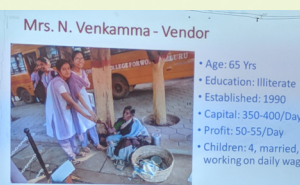
and “Women in Research” respectively. Dr CA Jyothirmayee, presented a paper on “Understanding family structure and women empowerment in India” .
