The management thanked Dr.N. Nagavardhanam for her fruitful service to the college



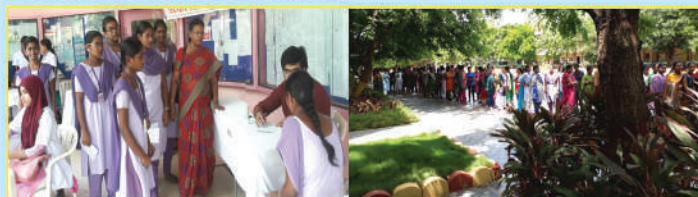
