

The College has maintained its position of excellence in the country imparting quality education in a sustainable environment. Our College which was one of the first to undergo for voluntary NAAC Accreditation way back in 1997 completed its 4th cycle of assessment and accreditation by National Assessment and Accreditation Council, Bangalore in September 2017 thereby maintaining its top-notch position as a lead college in the State and Country with an A+ grade with a CGPA 3.56/4, a status so far enjoyed only by two Colleges in Andhra Pradesh.

This rare distinction has earned us the title College of Excellence in 2018 from MHRD, Government of India, making us as one of the 38 Autonomous Colleges all over India to be chosen under RUSA (Rashtriya Utchata Sansar Abiyan) 2.0 under Component 8 to receive financial aid of Rs.5 crore for further Enhancement of Quality and Excellence.
