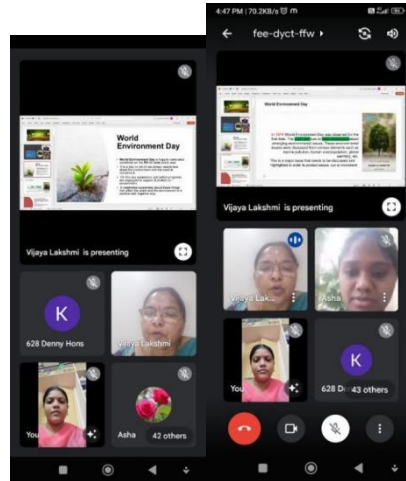

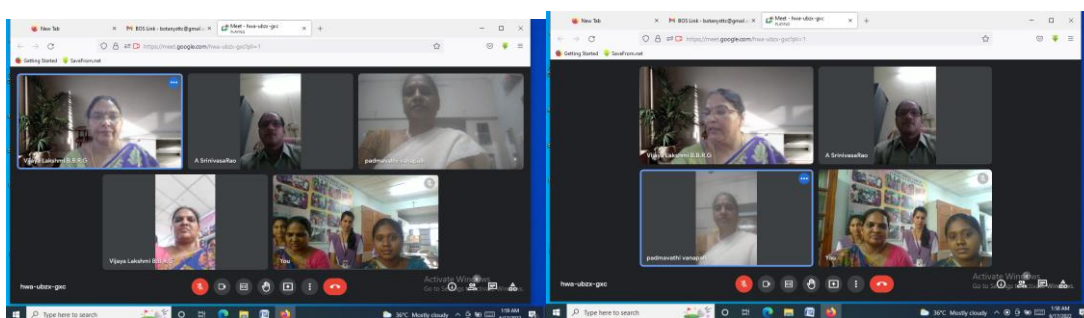

15. 6th July 2022: Installation of Mulching sheet in Theresian organic kitchen garden -

Before the installation of mulching sheet, prepared a flat primary bed and removed the big stones, weeds etc because which can cause damage the mulching sheet. Covered the bed by stretching the mulching sheet evenly. Mulching was done with mulching sheet in order to prevent the wind and sun drying the bare soil and to control the weed growth. Made a holes with the help of a hot pipe to plant the chilli and lady's finger plants.



16. 7th July 2022: Soil preparation for leafy vegetables and seed sowing – Allotted area

made as small plots for sowing the seeds. Shoveled the plots to loosen and aerate the soil. Removed all the rocks and weeds from the plot. Finally, rake the entire area and created garden beds. In each plot broadcasted leafy vegetable seeds like thotakura, gongura, menthikura, chukkura, palakura, pudina and kothimeera.



17. 8th July 2022: Plantation in Theresian Organic kitchen garden – Due to the heavy

rains some plants were damaged. So, in each plot one variety of vegetable saplings like 150 saplings of brinjal, 150 saplings of cluster bean, 50 saplings of tomato, 150 saplings of chilli and 150 saplings of lady's finger were planted. Pudina and Sweet potato plants are planted in between the spaces of two mulched beds.



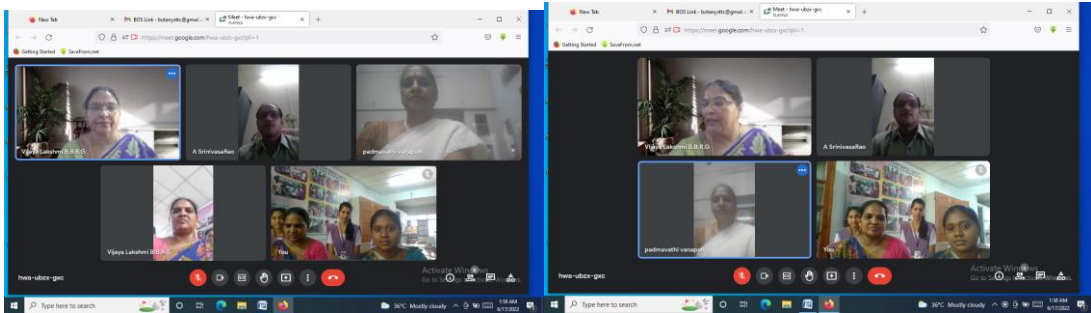

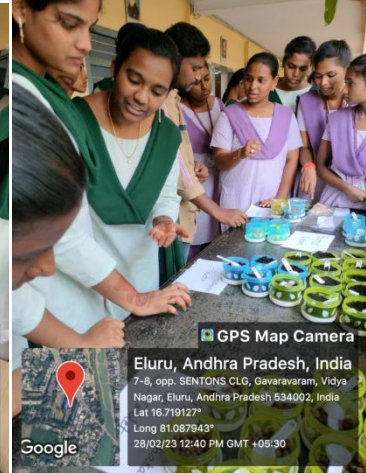
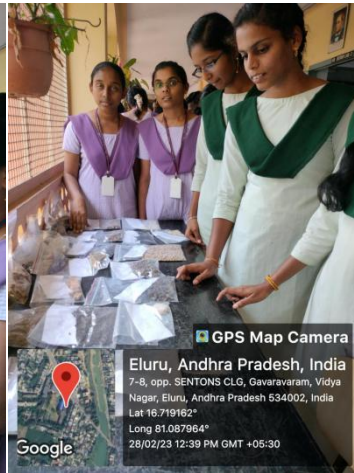
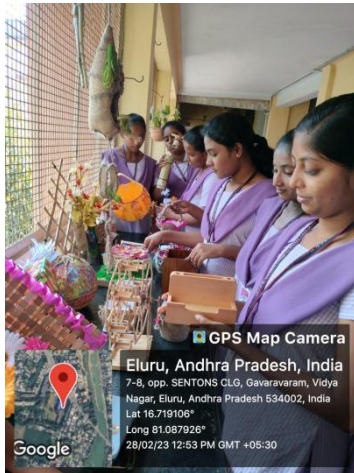
of black pepper. Fry all these material in ghee, then make it as fine powder. This choornam is used to immunity booster and also used to cure cough and cold.

Raw materials which are used in the preparation of herbal medicines also displayed in the exhibition. Several varieties of medicinal plants, indoor plants including some rare plants were displayed. II BZC students prepared different eco-friendly decorative models were also exhibited by using plant parts and plant products.



46. 2nd March 2023: Preparation of Herbal medicine - Under the guidance of Dr.B.B.R.G.Vijaya Lakshmi, Botany internship students Sindhu, Spandana, Prasanthi and Nirmla prepared herbal medicine like Lehyam. The raw materials are 150gms of guggilam powder, 30gms of turmeric powder pour in 350gms of coconut oil mixed well. Then this mixture pour in bucket which contain full of water. Immediately rubbed the mixture gently by using both the hands. Finally burnol is ready which is used to reduce the burning sensation and pain, provides immediate relief from the burn, prevent burning wound infections.
