Sr. Ernestine Fernandes gave blessings and advised the students to build the good characters like dedication, hard work etc of Mother Enrichetta. Dr. Sr. Mercy, principal gave message about the virtues of Blessed Mother Enrichetta and congratulated the efforts put up by the department of Botany in making this programme a grand success. Field Trips:

1. **29th July 2023: Filed trip** - Botany department organized a field trip to II & III BZC students to Kadium nurseries, Rajamahendravaram. 46 students attended this field trip and visited one of the most famous garden in India - “Pallam Venkanna plant nursery”, Kadiyapulanka, Rajamahendravaram. Students observed maintenance, they witness to natural gardens with air and water purifying plants like Hydrilla, Certophyllum etc. They came to know about cultivating practices of white, red and pink coloured lotuses in lotus pond which attracts people. Students gain the knowledge about growing methods of different Bonsai plants with different sizes and in shapes like 10cm to 10mts high in different containers. They came to know about maintaining polyhouses in the nursery, which were decorated with indoor plant creepers and money plants are planted in pots and arranged in shelf's.

Different varieties of indoor and outdoor flowering plants were planted in different shapes of indoor decorative planters. 30 colours of all Rose and flower plant varieties are arranged in different plots. They displayed wild as well as cultivated fruit yielding plant varieties like Black guava, anjeera, Jackfruit red etc and different vegetable seeds varieties from Raddish to Bitter gourd were observed by the students. Marketing strategies of the nursery was explained by Palla Venkanna which they are supplying different high quality UV plant varieties of indoor and outdoor, Bioenzymes and vermicompost to the customers. Propagating techniques of the ornamental, indoor to outdoor decorative plants was observed in the nursery.

Nursery was well established with different plants, fruit and farm varieties with different shapes which include high yielding fruits and vegetables. Even with rare medicinal plant varieties. Dr.B.B.R.G.Vijaya Lakshmi, HOD of Botany & Mrs.D.Lumbini Devi, Agriculture faculty accompanied the students. Students gained the knowledge about Biodiversity of Godavari River basin and enjoyed a lot.

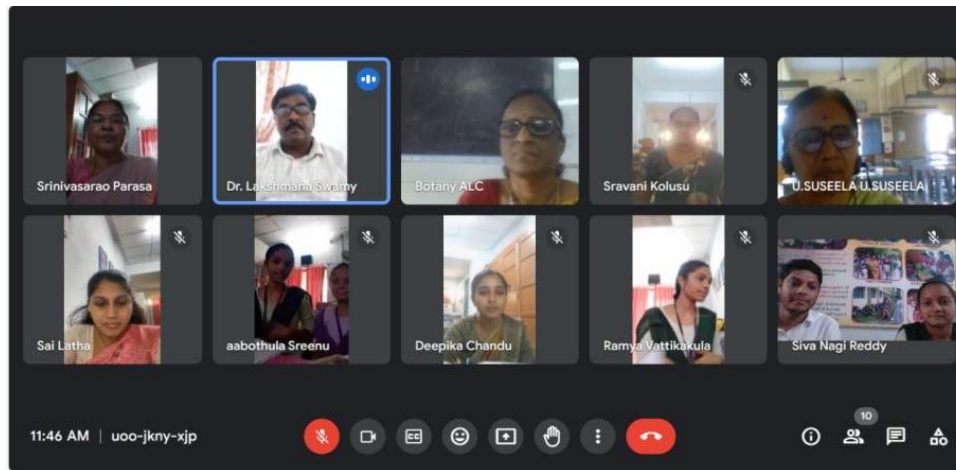
BOS attended:

4. **August 2023 to February 2024: Theresian Organic Kitchen garden** - a) **Transplantation of vegetable saplings** – Botany department along with II and III BZC students reestablished the Theresian Organic Kitchen garden near the community college at Ch.S.D.St.Theresa’s College for Women (A), Eluru. The main aim of establishing Theresian organic kitchen garden is to produce the chemical free vegetables and to maintain high nutritional quality in vegetables. The kitchen garden

area is divided into plots. Students made each plot as furrows and ridges. Each row was allotted to each student of II and III BZC students. 130 Brinjal, tomato, chilli and cluster bean saplings were planted in the organic kitchen garden during morning hours for safe growth. III BZC students transplanted dwarf dolichos bean, Marigold, Lady's finger and creeping vegetable saplings like Bitter gourd, Ridge gourd and Bottle gourd in the Theresian Organic Kitchen. Students also sowed the seeds of French bean, Pumpkin on side of the kitchen garden. Botany faculty Dr.B.B.R.G.Vijaya Lakshmi, HOD of Botany, Mrs.G.Rani guided and help the students to put up today's programme.



b) Theresian Organic Kitchen Garden: Intercultural Operations – III BZC removed weeds in the Theresian Organic Kitchen garden. They sprayed Neem oil pesticide to control the pests on Brinjal plants. Botany faculty Dr.B.B.R.G.Vijaya Lakshmi, HOD of Botany, Mrs.G.Rani guided the students.



c) Thersian Organic Kitchen Garden:Harvesting of vegetables - III BZC students harvested and marketed cluster beans and Brinjal to staff. Principal Dr.Sr.Mercy.P, Vice Principal.Sr.Maria Christia congratulated botany faculty and students.



5. 9th August 2023: Puddling the Rice fields – III BZC students did puddling manually without the using of cultivators in Rice fields of St.Ann’s convent for transplanting of black paddy crop. Students are actively involved in the puddling, enjoyed and learned the puddling techniques. Botany faculty Dr.B.B.R.G.Vijaya Lakshmi, HOD of Botany, Mrs.G.Rani encouraged the students to learn and practice the Agricultural techniques.





6. **1stSeptember 2023: Mushroom cultivation unit visit** – Botany department organized a visit to III BZC students to Mushroom cultivation unit in our college campus maintained by Agriculture department. Mr.V.Siva Nagi Reddy, Agriculture faculty explained the process and cultivation techniques of Mushroom.

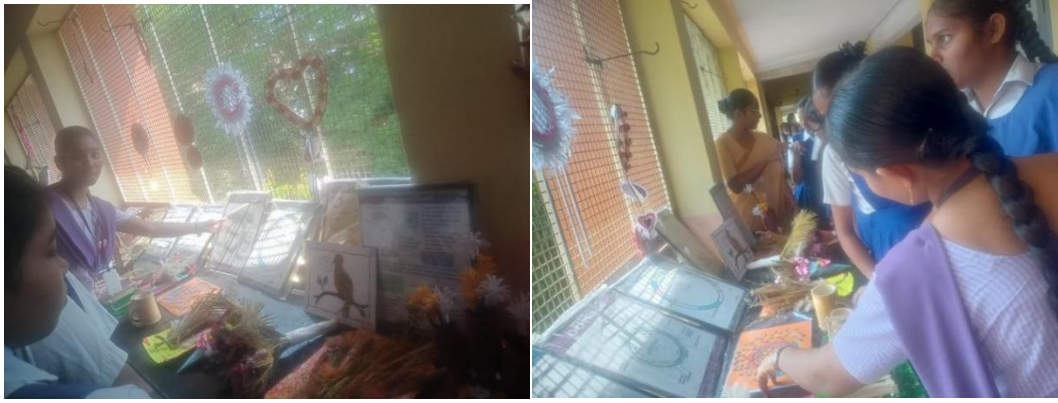
